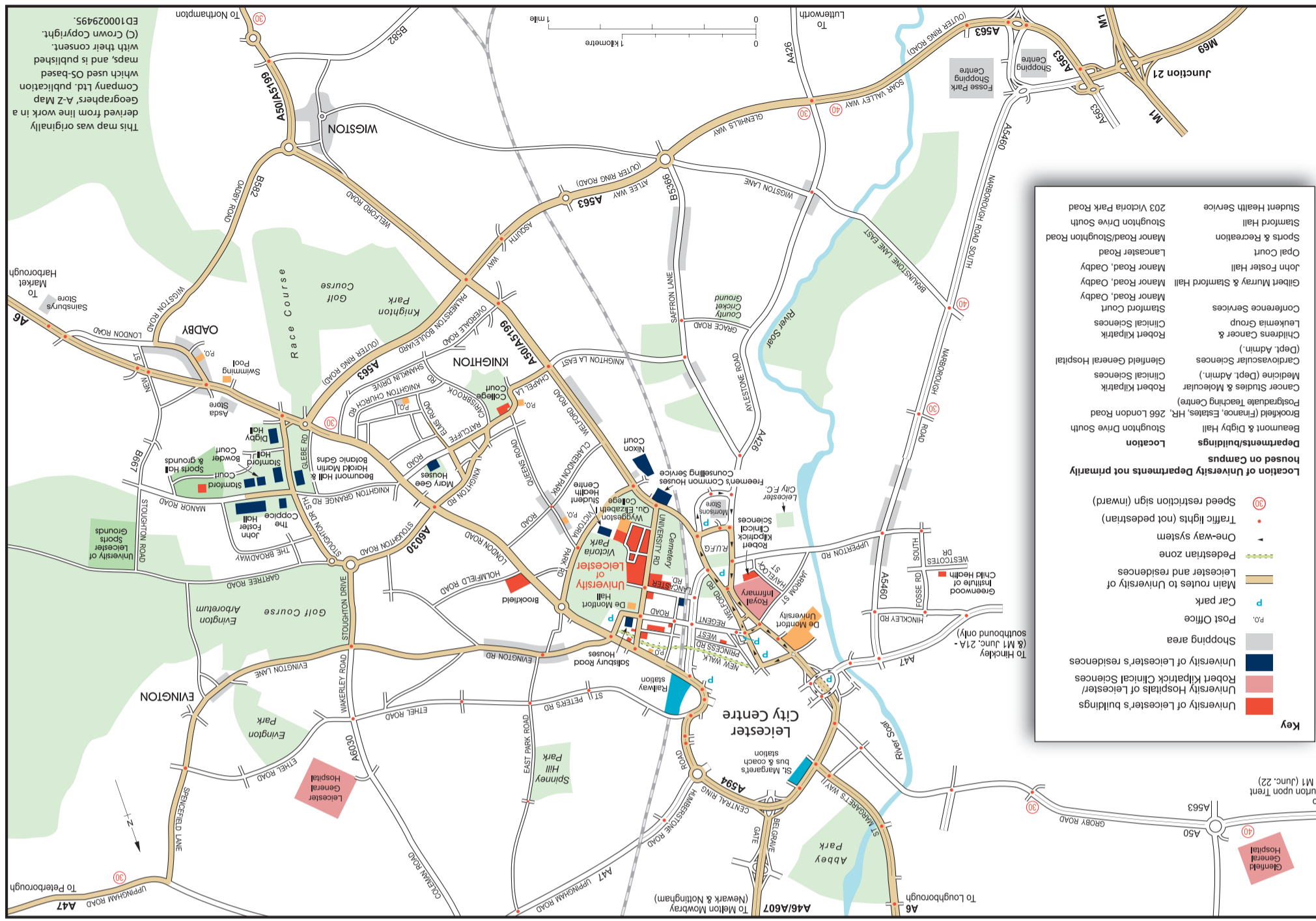

Local bus services to the University from the City Centre include: Arriva Routes 47 and 48 from St Margaret's Bus Station and Route 80 from Charles Street. See www.arrivabus.co.uk for details.

From Market Street the University may be reached on foot in 20-25 minutes: walk down King Street and turn left along New Walk, a pleasant Georgian pedestrian way, passing the Museum and Art Gallery; until you reach University Road then turn right along University Road.

From the City Centre

There are direct bus services to Leicester from the regional airports: Birmingham International and East Midlands (Nottingham, Leicester, Derby), and from London-Heathrow and London-Gatwick airports as well as direct trains from East Midlands, London-Stansted and London-Luton.
